It has 13,000 members with nearly €400 million in assets under management. The contributions paid by elected officials during their term of office are topped up 100% by their local authority. The scheme then offers local elected officials a guaranteed and secure life annuity, which is regularly revalued. This scheme benefits from a regulatory framework perfectly suited to the management of long-term commitments and the financing of the real economy, including the development of French territories.
