He also contributes to the launch of the DIALog (Digital Insurance And Long-Term Risk) Chair of Excellence focusing on artificial intelligence applied to the insurance sector. Until 2019, he was manager of the Methods and Innovation department.

He is a research fellow at the Sciences Actuarielle et Financière (Actuarial and Financial Science) laboratory and a lecturer and researcher in various universities both in France and abroad, he is a reviewer for the European Actuarial Journal, he holds various responsibilities in bodies of the Institut des Actuaire, the French Actuarial Institute.
